On 8 May 2017, on the occasion of celebrating the Day of Old Town Sarajevo Municipality, the International Forum Bosnia will organize a public presentation titled *SARAJEVO AND BOSNIA IN FILMS BY PJER ŽALICA*. The presentation will be held at the hotel *Europe* and will start at 19:00 hours.

Career achievements of Pjer Žalica will be presented by Srđan Vuletić, who will talk with him. Hatidža Nuhić will moderate the presentation.

Pjer Žalica is a professor at the Academy of Performing Arts in Sarajevo. The area of his academic field is film in the broadest sense. And even more than that. His films, marked with fundamental author's impact, are acknowledged as an important contribution to Bosnian and world culture: *At Uncle Idriz's (2004); Fire is Burning (2003); Mostar Sevdah Reunion (2000); The End of Unpleasant Times (1998); Made in Sarajevo (1998); MGM Sarajevo: Man, God, Monster (1994)*.

Srđan Vuletić is a professor at the Academy of Performing Arts in Sarajevo. His academic field is also film in the broadest sense. He made documentaries and feature films which made a significant contribution to Bosnian and world culture: *It is difficult to be nice (2007); Summer in Golden Valley (2003); 10 Minutes (2002); Triple Jump (2000); I set legs on fire (1993), Orthodox Church (1991)*.

Hatidža Nuhić is an author and a TV anchor, and she has participated in production of various Bosnian films.

Presentation is open to the general public.
